Confirmation Service Hours

“Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven.” - Matthew 5:16

All students participating in our confirmation “Purpose” program are required to complete a specified number of service hours throughout the year prior to Confirmation. **Regardless of grade level, all those who plan to be Confirmed in the spring must complete a minimum of twenty-five (25) service hours.**

Please begin planning and scheduling these opportunities soon. All hours are required to be documented, submitted & approved prior to **March 30th** and we strongly encourage that these hours be equally fulfilled between the two (2) sections shown below. Examples of ways that you can serve **inside our parish**:

- Ushering
- Altar serving
- Lectoring @ youth mass
- Singing/playing in the youth choir
- Helping the Sacristan
- Attending parish events (Lenten Missions, Parish rosary, etc.)
- Assisting the Knights of Columbus for various events
- Making cards for / helping homebound parishioners
- Attending Monthly Parish Rosary
- Working in the flower beds
- Any service events organized by St. Edmond Catholic Church

Examples of ways that you can serve **outside our parish**:

- Serving food at St. Joseph’s Diner
- Creating “First Night” Bags at Foster the Love
- “Homeless to House Warmed”
- Creating “Blessing Bags” for the homeless
- Participating in LARC events where help is needed
- Attending Nursing Homes to visit / help / sing to the residents (Masion De Goodwill & Magnolia)

Note: Any hours spent serving in our community, **outside** St. Edmond church parish and any of its ministries, will count as double. School functions do not apply.
